Richard Steven Valenzuela, known professionally as Ritchie Valens,(1941-1959) was an American guitarist, singer and songwriter. A rock and roll pioneer and a forefather of the Chicano rock movement, Valens was killed in a plane crash eight months into his music career.

"La Bamba" is originally an 18th-century folk song that comes from the Veracruz region on the Mexican Gulf Coast. It also refers to a dance performed mainly at weddings.
