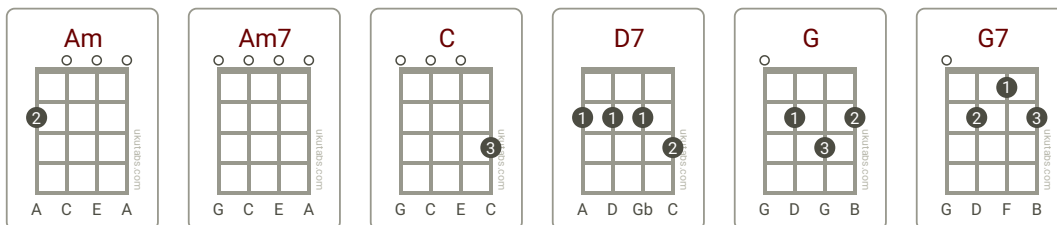


ROCKY RACCOON
