Yes, I lost my little darlin', the night they were playing,

F C7 F F  
the beautiful Tennessee Waltz.

## INSTRUMENTAL - from the top

F F F7 Bb  
Now I wonder how a dance like the Tennessee Waltz

F D7 G7 C7  
Could have broken my heart so complete

F F F7 Bb  
Well, I couldn't blame my darlin', and who could help fallin'

F C7 F F  
In love with my darlin' so sweet.

F A7 Bb F  
Well, it must be the fault of the Tennessee Waltz,

F D7 G7 C7  
Wish I'd known just how much it would cost.

F F F7 Bb  
But I didn't see it commin', it's all over but the cryin'

F C7 F  
Blame it all on the Tennessee Waltz.
