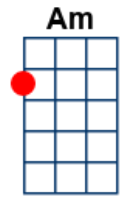

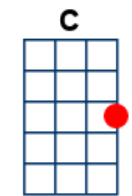

In Dublin's fair city, where the girls are so pretty,



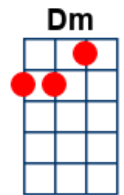
C **Am** **F** **G7**

As she wheeled her wheel barrow

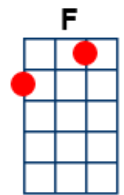
Dm **G7**

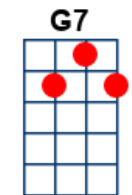
