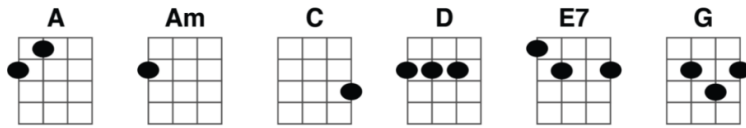


Summer Nights

M: [G] So I [C] told her [D] we'd still be [C] friends

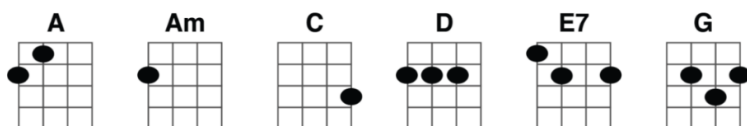
W: [G] Then we [C] made [D] our true love [E7] vow
