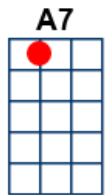

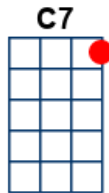

Intro: **G7 C7 F** (last line, verse 2)



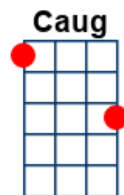
**D7**

They all sigh and wanna die for... Sweet Georgia Brown

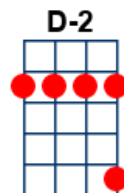
**Caug** **F**

You know I don't lie (not much!)

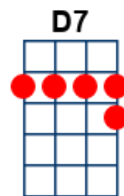
**D7**

Since she came why it's a shame how... she's cooled 'em down



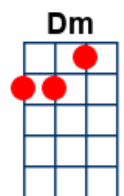
**Dm** **A7**

Georgia claimed her, Georgia named her

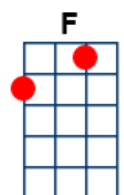
**G7** **C7** **F**

and **F** Who's that mister ... "
