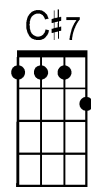
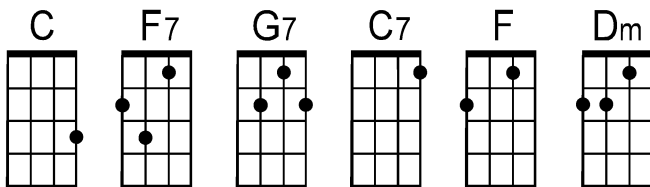


Walking After Midnight
