
# Little Honda by Brian Wilson and Mike Love 1964 FIRST VERSE: "Go!"

Third [D] gear, hang on [G] tight.


[A] Faster, it's all [A7] right.

[A] Faster, it's all [A7] right.


## THIRD VERSE:

I better [A] turn on the lights,




